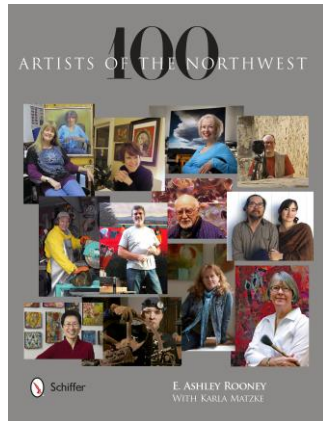

**Schrager & Clarke Gallery** is pleased to present another in a series of exhibits by **Nelson Sandgren**. Sandgren, who lived and taught in Corvallis, is well-known to Northwest art lovers for his portrayal of the land, sea, and forest of our area. He was a major influence on other regional artists, who often joined him in weeklong painting sessions on the Oregon coast.

This exhibit is an eclectic mixture of work from the various periods in his life. Some of the earliest pieces, from the 1940s, are casein or oil painted in Mexico; a later trip to Mexico in the 1970s resulted in black and white prints. Then there are all the other decades before his death in 2006, during which he produced work exhibiting his wonderful use of color and his lively brush technique. This varied overview makes for an exciting retrospective sampling.

In conjunction with this exhibit, we will host a Reception and Book Signing Party to celebrate the publication of 100 Artists of the Northwest. On Saturday, February 22<sup>nd</sup> a number of local and regional artists who are featured in this book, including Nelson's son Erik Sandgren, and who are exhibitors at our gallery, will be on hand to sign copies of this beautifully produced book. Books will be available at the gallery for a cost of \$50. We hope you will join us to congratulate these artists whose work has given this community such pleasure.
