This year, RAIN or SHINE with WIND, we will again bring our PAINTING efforts to the Oregon Coast. Prepare as ever for weather and portability. Please note that our itinerary this year has us mostly painting consecutive days at each location. The final two days in Newport may be partially allocated to a project in collaboration with an upcoming exhibition at Oregon State University. Stay tuned for news about that.

The first day we will gather at Ona Beach State Park anytime beginning 10:00 am. There is no special ceremony scheduled beyond the acts of painting and sharing warm-up work in the afternoon! This day is to moisten the brushes, test your portability, greet old friends and meet new people.

**The Embedded Workshop is the only fee-based activity of the PaintOut.** The Workshop concludes each of the three class days with critique based on the assigned challenge of the day. Workshop painters meet at 4:00 pm. to share work done or begun on location that day. **PaintOut Free-for-Allers join us at 5:00 pm!**

**Pre-registered Embedded Workshop participants** will stay grouped July 10,11 and 12. If you have come to the PaintOut to join the Free-for All (not registered for the Embedded Watercolor Workshop) please feel free to stick close OR choose painting sites most advantageous to YOURSELF. Consider your interests in subject matter, wind, changing light conditions and etc.. REGARDLESS of where you paint, feel free to bring your day's work to the designated review site by 5:00 pm. The Open Review will commence at 5:00 pm sharp each day (except for the "free day" on Sunday, 15 July). After the Open Reviews all are welcome to return to painting the late afternoon and evening light.

Class size is limited. Registration for the workshop is first-come-first-served. Last year's participants are notified first. To reserve a spot please post a \$25 non refundable deposit to me at 4815 NW Kahneeta Court, Portland, OR 97229. Your balance of \$300 is due on the first day of the workshop July 10. During the workshop I will again emphasize NEW content within a familiar atmosphere of focused discussion, individual instruction and demonstration. Specific problems/ challenges /assignments are put forward to encourage your re-focus on fundamentals as well as your individual responses to the shared locale. Critiques emphasize painting fundamentals and are specific to the challenges under discussion. Serious (not grim) painters at all skill levels are welcome.

Having encouraged a personal choice of painting sites, it is all the more important for EVERYONE to gather at 5:00 pm each day for the Open Review. Each afternoon we informally share the paintings done or begun that day and discuss locations most favored for the following morning. Cell and Web access can be shaky in places. It remains indispensable to gather really, rather than virtually. I have been asked to say that dogs at gatherings and reviews can be a real problem. Please make the appropriate arrangements for your beloved companions.
